Kindergarten - Our littlest learners are motivated and excited to read now that they've learned several characteristics and strategies of good readers and received their very own book bags with their "just right" level books! K students just conducted their very first writing celebration to close out our launching unit and will now begin writing pattern books! In this unit, students will continue to practice stretching out words and writing a complete sentence.

1st Grade- First graders have been enjoying learning how to become strong readers. We are dropping bad habits and learning how to figure out tricky words. We have also been using several different craft moves in writing workshop. In math, we are continuing to work on addition and subtraction strategies.

2nd Grade- Second graders are exploring plants and how they grow. In Social Studies, we are creating maps of ourselves in our town, our state, our country, our continent, and our planet. We are learning strategies for solving subtraction story problems.

3rd Grade - Third graders are busy editing and revising their small moment stories. Their first published piece will be ready soon!  
In reading, we are working on characters. Please ask your children questions about the characters they are reading about.

4th Grade - Fourth graders are in full swing. We are choosing and reading books at our just right levels, we are studying and writing narrative pieces and analyzing measurements and data. We are getting excited for Halloween and can't wait to see everyone's costumes at the Halloween Parade!

5th Grade- Fifth Graders have been learning alternative strategies to solve long division and multiplication problems- This is helping them to build their number sense. We are learning to show and not tell in our narrative writing and loving reading our adventures and survival independent reading books on our new comfy cushions.
