JEFFERSON SCHOOL PARKING REGULATIONS

Dear Parent,

Welcome back for another exciting school year. For the parents that are returning to the school, this is just a reminder. For the parents who are new, this letter will inform you of when and where you can park around the school area. The following is a list of parking regulations for Jefferson School area:

- There is **NO PARKING** on **Prospect Street** from 8 AM to 4 PM during school days on the west curb line (opposite the cemetery). This regulation is for the general public.
- The front of Jefferson School is a drop-off zone for the beginning of school and a pick-up zone for dismissal. You **cannot park** your vehicle for any length of time in this area when you drop-off at the beginning of school. For pick-up at dismissal, you can park in this area but must leave as soon as your child is secure in your vehicle.
- Any area that has a **yellow curb** painted is a **NO PARKING** area.
- You can park your vehicle on **Prospect Street** north of the school in any area that is **not painted yellow** or **not posted NO PARKING** and escort your child to and from the school.
- You can park on **Highview Road** in any area that is **not posted NO PARKING** and escort your child to and from school.

Idling of a parked motor vehicle, diesel or gasoline, for more than three minutes is a violation of NJ Statute 39:3-70.2. The minimum penalty for this violation is \$250.00. I urge all parents to turn their vehicles off when parked on the side of the road while waiting to pick up your child(ren).
