Dear Parents/Guardians,

President Bush signed into law the "No Child Left Behind Act" of 2001 on January 8, 2002. It redefines the federal role in K-12 education and outlines the government's responsibility in funding school programs.

This act also provides that military recruiters be given lists of the names, addresses, and telephone numbers of high school students. The intent is to provide all students with information about the benefits of serving the military, which is an option for students graduating from high school.

Another part of this legislation requires schools to provide recruiters the same access to secondary schools as is provided to post-secondary educational institutions or prospective employers.

This law does provide students and parents the right not to have the name, address, and telephone number information released. If you chose to have your child's name removed from the roster released to the Armed Forces, please check the appropriate box within the Genesis Parent Portal forms, OR print and complete the form below and return to the Guidance Office by the last school day of September.

The law <u>does not</u> change the requirement for eighteen-year-old males to register with the Selective Service System.
