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## Board of Education (B.O.E.) Notes

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*Thank you to Chris Elko for attending this meeting in Liz Amador's absence on behalf of Wilson School HSA*

- The meeting began with a presentation by Principal Brown and some 8th graders and a teacher. The topic was the new Service Leadership Class that they started this year. Students commit to 9 hours of community service each marking period and there is additional in-class instruction and review. The school is now looking at doing a school-wide service project.
- Dr. Heinegg gave his bi-annual report on Violence and Vandalism. For the period of 7/1/18-12/31/18, there were three incidents of physical violence (2 for the JCHS; 1 for GCMS). There were 10 allegations of "HIB" (Harassment, Intimidation and Bullying). Five of the allegations were confirmed (1 at JCHS; 2 at GCMS; 1 at Jefferson). Most, if not all, of the allegations qualified as "demeaning comments".
- The Agenda (link [here](#)) passed without much comment. One person inquired as to why we used two aides for one person (Section B(2)(e)) and the Board indicated that it is standard practice to use two part timers to create additional flexibility.
- An individual from [Pre-School Advantage](#) spoke (from the floor- not on the agenda) about their program, which reduces cost for kids to attend pre-school.

- I (Chris Elko) asked about the Kindergarten Curriculum and was told that it will be based on the state guidelines (as before) but there is a group getting together in the spring to flesh out what the full day schedule will look like.
